Invitation to the 3rd Equine Science Education Workshop 2011, EAAP (Schedule below)

In recent meetings one issue keeps returning during our discussions, the issue that has originally led to the formation of the Equine Science Education Working Group under the Horse Commission: How do we pass our scientific knowledge and understanding on to students and to practitioners? How can we incorporate science with applied knowledge – get the message through to the end uses (something we scientists are often accused of not being very good at). To this effect this year's Equine Science Education Workshop will focus on sharing good practice in this area (Session 1) and it will inform about the latest developments of the joint European Equine Masters Programme by the Equine Masters Working Group – under the leadership of Klemen Potočnik (Session 2). In Session 3 we will look at developing collaborative teaching or assessment materials whereas the parallel Session 4 will be focusing on the future development of the Masters Programme.
